



## MAR – LU – RIDGE JOB DESCRIPTION



**Title:** Adventure Counselor

**Primary Function:** As a member of the summer camp staff, the Adventure Counselor will be assigned a small group to lead for a week possibly in the wilderness, be sent to a local church, work at MLR's day camp or provide general staff support. The Adventure Counselor shall support the ministry and fulfill the vision and mission of Mar-Lu-Ridge through day-to-day activities as assigned.

### **Principal Responsibilities:**

- Supervise the health, welfare and happiness for each camper during their time at MLR
- Exercise discretion, judgment and reason while supervising campers off-site
- Share the Gospel and summer curriculum through Bible studies and informal ministry
- Plan and lead daily activities for the campers under their direction
- Perform extra duties like paperwork, training and certifications to run the adventure program
- Perform staff projects and support activities when not assigned to a group
- Be flexible and adaptable while taking initiative and following directions
- Bring any serious concerns or problems to a Director
- Maintain clean private and public areas
- Be a positive Christian role model for campers and staff
- Attend staff training and adventure training
- Assist with evening activities, worships and other programs as needed
- Perform other duties and serve the camp in ways not specified in this job description

### **Direction/Guidance Received:**

- Works under the supervision of the Associate Director and Administrative Staff
- Follows the staff policies and procedures as outlined in the Staff Manual and during staff training.

### **Qualifications:**

- Minimum of a High School Diploma
- Capable of prolonged physical activity and an active outdoor lifestyle
- Over 21 years of age at the start of the camp season (preferred)
- Advanced outdoor recreation certifications (preferred)
- Previous experience working with youth (strongly preferred)
- Passion for Christ and knowledge of ELCA theology (strongly preferred)
