Title: Nature Director

Primary Function: As a member of the summer camp administrative staff, the Nature Director will lead the Nature programming and perform a variety of other support for the summer staff. The Nature Director shall support the ministry and fulfill the vision and mission of Mar-Lu-Ridge.

Principal Responsibilities:

- Administer and supervise camp nature supplies using the allocated budget
- Prepare educational, engaging and Christian nature activities for groups
- Relate the nature sessions to the Gospel and summer curriculum
- Keep the nature cabin clean and safe through proper cleanup and storage of supplies
- Open and close the nature cabin at the beginning and end of the camp season
- Uphold the camp goals and philosophy
- Be a positive Christian role model for campers and staff
- Be flexible and adaptable while taking initiative and following directions
- Attend staff training
- Assist with evening activities and other programs as needed
- Perform other duties and serve the camp in ways not specified in this job description

Direction/Guidance Received:

- Works under the supervision of the Associate Director and alongside the Administrative Staff
- Follows the staff policies and procedures as outlined in the Staff Manual and during staff training.

- Passion for Christ and knowledge of ELCA theology (strongly preferred)
