Camp community - Building lifelong friendships

A message from the Executive Director:

While the continuing struggles of 2021 related to the pandemic brought many sorrows, we also found many reasons to rejoice. We know that God is very present, and that was evident as we successfully hosted campers again and welcomed back large retreat groups. Each person who spent time on the Ridge brought their own burdens to lay down, and their own joys to share. We feel humbled to continue this ministry that touches people from all walks of life, and allows space for God to walk alongside people on their faith journey.

The retreat guests began to arrive in larger and larger groups as the year went on, and we served over 2,350 people: youth groups, adult mentoring groups, church councils and Scouts. Many families came to rent cabins again and found peace and relaxation among the trees. The campfires brought folks together as community, and our hospitality allowed our guests to feel nourished and cared for in a genuine way.

The heart of our ministry, our summer camp, happened with zero incidents of COVID after much careful planning, and we give thanks to God for that joy. The campers brought their laughter and enthusiasm, their fears and struggles, their whole selves to this place. A place where they know they are loved and accepted as precious children of God.

Our summer staff was small but filled with love and leadership as they provided a unique, safe, fun-filled camp experience for everyone.

One of the year's best celebrations centered around the Conservation Easement with the State of Maryland. After 5 years of hard work, the easement was secured, helping to preserve all 455 acres of Mar-Lu-Ridge land forever. The decision to enter into this agreement is in keeping with our mission statement, which reads in part, "...and encourages care of God's creation." We feel that preserving the natural state of our forests, streams, ponds and flora will provide habitat for wildlife, and an outdoor sanctuary for our community for generations to come. The Board of Directors voted unanimously to enter into the agreement on January 31, 2020.

We acknowledge the Piscataway tribes, who utilized this land for hunting and shelter, and the many families who utilized the forests as woodlots and the open space as farmland prior to the sale of the land to the Maryland Synod in 1959. We remain committed to stewarding the property and its resources in keeping with the mission of Mar-Lu-Ridge, and with the details set forth in our easement. Together, we have secured the future of Mar-Lu-Ridge for generations to come. Thanks be to God!

As we enter a new year, I know that our challenges are not fully behind us, but we are on solid ground because of our synod support, our generous and faithful donor community, and our ability to serve in new and familiar ways. We thank God for the strong foundation of community here at Mar-Lu-Ridge.

Associate Director's Report

I am incredibly grateful for all the blessings our MLR community has experienced this camping season. It has been an absolute joy to have the sounds of campers' laughter and singing fill our beloved camp once again. This summer was not without its challenges, but we worked hard to follow all COVID protocols and it was wonderful to be doing what we do best once again.

Our theme this summer was "Created with Care," in which we explored God's Good Creation and our call to be good stewards of all God's gifts. We focused on the themes of water, land and plants, animals, and humans – learning more about each element of Creation and what we can do to better care for it. Our campers and staff explored what Jesus' "Living Water" means (John 4:10). We shared our Land Acknowledgement, remembering that we are not the first inhabitants of this home. We marveled at the wonder of all God's critters, thankful for their lessons of patience and trust. We embraced our call to love one another, and explored what it means to "lay down one's life for one's friends" (John 15:13).

We had 207 camper registrations this summer, with a total of 180 participants. Our dedicated staff of 15 young adults led with faith and enthusiasm.

I had the wonderful opportunity to complete my Clinical Pastoral Education this summer, which meant I took on a new role as the Summer Camp Chaplain. This was a challenging and enriching experience for me. I am so grateful for Liam Fyfe, Program Coordinator, who was able to take on some of my regular Associate Director duties, to free up more time for me to provide pastoral care for our campers and staff.

Thank you all for your continued support of this ministry. As my time at Mar-Lu-Ridge ends, I am just so grateful for the experiences I have had and the people I have met here. I have grown in my understandings of ministry and what it means to be the Church. I have gained confidence and found my voice as a leader in this community. I have built relationships that I believe will continue to bloom and grow. Thank you, thank you, for your prayers and support as I take this next step. God be with you, until we meet again.

Financial Report for 2021

During 2021, Mar-Lu-Ridge began the return to regular operations, even as it faced a second year of pandemic-imposed restrictions. In-person summer camp sessions re-opened at roughly half of their pre-Covid capacity, with the result that summer camp revenue (net of refunds) more than tripled relative to 2020. Similarly, revenues from retreats and other camp usage (net of refunds) more than doubled relative to 2020. MLR operations also benefitted from the forgiveness of two Federal Payroll Protection Program loans, a government policy designed to avoid pandemic-induced layoffs.

Over the year as a whole, MLR realized an operating loss of \$103,501, which was off-set by funds from the Conservation Easement as we worked to rebuild business income in the midst of COVID.

The Conservation Easement contract from the Maryland Department of Natural Resources has provided a long-run benefit to MLR operations and upholds our mission statement. In March 2021, Mar-Lu-Ridge was formally included in the State's Project Open Space program and all 455 acres of property stewarded and operated by Mar-Lu-Ridge are now protected. The funds received have been used to finance both the 2021 operating loss and a long-term capital endowment fund.

To meet financial challenges going forward, MLR remains dependent on donations, grants, and Synodical support as well as increased revenue from retreats and camps to meet its expenses. Fortunately, God continues to generously bless the Camp with congregations and individuals, staff and volunteers who are dedicated to supporting its vital ministry. As always, your financial support and earnest prayers are essential and very much appreciated by everyone who experiences Mar-Lu-Ridge.
