Mar-Lu-Ridge Procedures: Health & Well-being

These procedures have been developed and updated with the guidance from the American Camp Association (ACA), the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), and the Maryland Department of Health. The health and safety of our guests and campers is our highest priority.

Guests and Campers:

- Mar-Lu-Ridge is private property and is closed to the general public
- All guests and campers must be registered
- All guests and campers must check in upon arrival by calling the camp host (number available in "Welcome" note).
- If you are ill or experiencing any cold or flu symptoms, or have been exposed to an individual known to have COVID, please stay home.
- **Face coverings are now optional**. Please choose your comfort level.

Staff:

- Staff will self-monitor and stay home if unwell
- All staff must practice good hand washing hygiene.

Cleaning:

- Mar-Lu-Ridge housekeeping has been trained to the highest standards of cleaning and sanitizing, in accordance with ACA guidelines.
- Cleaning products are available in the cabins/lodge if you need to utilize them during your stay.
- All cleaning and sanitizing agents are EPA approved.

Public Areas:

- During summer camp, these shared areas will be cleaned each day. We encourage guests and campers to use facilities in their assigned space whenever possible.

Food Service:

- All guests and campers will sanitize hands prior to entering line for service.
- Once finished, each person is responsible for bussing their own plates and utensils.
