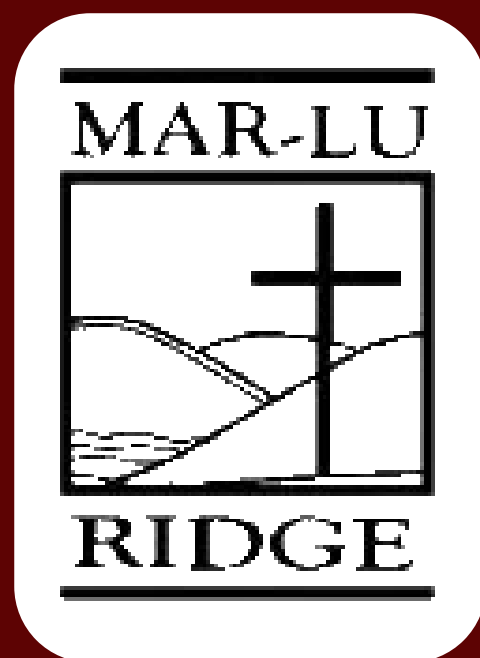

The With Open Arms Campaign for accessibility entered its third and final year, and renovations on the Ridge Inn continued in full swing until completion in July. Our conference center is now the home of a brand-new elevator, new HVAC systems, and three fully accessible, all-gender restrooms. We cannot wait to see the BIG impact these improvements will have on the guests who stay there!

In June, long-time Executive Director Sarah Lefler announced her intention to retire at the end of 2025, so we knew a big leadership change was on the horizon. Sarah's steady leadership and vision guided Mar-Lu-Ridge into a new chapter of radical welcome and acceptance, and hers would be BIG shoes to fill!

Words like BIG are incredibly important, shaping how we view the world around us. What do you think of when you picture a BIG moment for yourself, at camp or elsewhere?! Mar-Lu-Ridge's 2025 summer campers unpacked God Word by exploring...words! Our theme was *The Word: God's Story Then, Now and Always*. Each day campers and staff learned about God's story through a theme word: Trust, Blessing, Listen, Serve, and Follow. Tales from the Bible and camp activities like Bible Study, worship, challenge courses, pool time, crafts, archery, and nature study helped show how our theme verse from Romans can be brought to life in the past, present, and in our lives today.

God's story was joyfully written this year at Mar-Lu-Ridge. Our hard-working staff and volunteers remain a beacon of light and hope for our troubled world, ensuring that through the changes, Mar-Lu-Ridge is a place of safety, learning, acceptance, and peace.

Amy Asendorf Berger, and Becky Wright. We are grateful to this team and their dedication to a thorough search process. After much consideration, a candidate was presented to the board for vote. The candidate who was selected by the board was Diana Edelblute!

Diana served as Associate Director at Mar-Lu-Ridge since 2022, a position in which she has performed admirably. She brings a wealth of outdoor ministry and camp experience, including time as a counselor at Camp Nawakwa (PA) and progressive leadership in Outdoor/Environmental Education at YMCA Camp Seymour (WA). We are thrilled to have her on board to continue serving and leading at Mar-Lu-Ridge!

This year, two board members, Pastor Charlie Frekot and Rita Warner, were both offered professional opportunities that would pull them away from participating in the Mar-Lu-Ridge board, and resigned from board service. We are thankful for all the work they have done and for their steady leadership.

Finally, Mar-Lu-Ridge honored the service and legacy of outgoing executive director, Sarah Lefler. A celebration honoring her and her steadfast work on October 24, 2025, where she thanked the community for all they have accomplished together. Sarah was presented with gifts from the community, and thanked by Bishop Gohl. Stories were told and songs were sung in true Mar-Lu-Ridge fashion. Sarah has made a profound mark on Mar-Lu-Ridge and the community, and she will be missed.

FROM THE TREASURER: FINANCIAL REPORT & STATISTICS

Generous donations to the With Open Arms (WOA) capital campaign have made it possible to complete a wide variety of capital improvements. By the end of 2025, Mar-Lu-Ridge had received donations of over \$884 thousand for the campaign and had spend \$823 thousand on campaign projects. Projects at the Ridge Inn and elsewhere included a Ridge Inn elevator, improved HVAC systems, a paved Ridge Inn parking lot, new cabin mattresses and bathroom windows, and debt reduction for earlier capital projects. The remaining campaign surplus and future campaign donations will be used for capital improvements, maintenance and debt service.

During 2025, Mar-Lu-Ridge operating income remained relatively constant by comparison with 2024. Over the same period, operating costs increased by 6.5%.

To meet financial challenges as we prepare to welcome future generations, MLR remains dependent on donations, grants and Synodical support, as well as growth in revenue from retreats and camps, to meet its operating expenses. Fortunately, God continues to generously bless the Camp with congregations and individuals, staff and volunteers who are dedicated to supporting this vital ministry. As always, you financial support and earnest prayers are essential and are very much appreciated by everyone who experiences Mar-Lu-Ridge.
